REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Monday, May 20, 2019 is the deadline for ALL registrations for BOTH Las Vegas and Orlando. Registrations submitted after the deadline will incur full tuition prices.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Payments can be made via check or card to the National Dance Honors. Event information will not be released until full payment is processed. Payments must be paid in full prior the event

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

You may register via our online registration system or by mail. Phone registrations are not accepted.

Early registration tuition fees apply to all registrations created at least 30 days prior to the start of the event.

Registrations must be paid in full before any event information is released. This includes event schedules, competition orders, studio packets, scholarship numbers, wristbands, etc.

Space is limited, therefore registration at the door is not guaranteed. Workshop registrations are accepted at the door. On-site workshop registrations must be paid for in cash, credit card, or cashier’s check. Personal checks are not accepted at any time.



Competition entries cannot be added at the event.

Dancers are required to register for the entire workshop to be eligible to compete. Dancers are not required to compete in order to participate in the workshop.

We proudly accept independent registrations for the workshop. In order to compete, all dancers must be registered through a studio account.

Any scholarships will be verified in the office for all registrations. For mail-in registrations, please attach the scholarships to the workshop registration form.

All returned checks are subject to a \$35 fee.

Entry fees are Non-Refundable.

All registrations are required to pay a \$500 non-refundable deposit at time of registration to secure your spot, with all balances being paid in full 4 weeks prior to the event.

WRISTBANDS AND AUDITION NUMBERS

All paid dancers and Observers will receive a wristband to wear throughout the event. Anyone without a wristband will be denied entry. All Mini, Junior, Teen, and Senior dancers registered for the full workshop will receive an audition number in the Studio Director's packet.

TEACHERS

Prior to arriving at the National Dance Honors, each Teacher will receive an e-mail highlighting the special events for the week as well as the workshop and competition schedules.

Registered Teachers have access to all Sparks, Mini, Junior, Teen, and Senior workshop classes and scholarship auditions. In addition, all registered Teachers will have priority reserved seating for the competition and priority in booking Gala tickets. All Honored Dancer auditions are closed to Studio Directors and Teachers.

We invite all Studio Directors and Teachers to attend our "Director's Welcome Meeting." We will review all the exciting events and elements of the week and answer any last minute questions you may have.



TEACHER DISCOUNTS

5-14 full paying students = 1 FREE Teacher, 1 Gala Ticket
15-39 full paying students = 2 FREE Teachers, 2 Gala Tickets
40-59 full paying students = 3 FREE Teachers, 3 Gala Tickets, 1 Advantage Scholarship
60-79 full paying students = 4 FREE Teachers, 4 Gala Tickets, 1 Advantage Scholarship
80+ full paying students = 5 FREE Teachers, 5 Gala Tickets, 1 Advantage Scholarship

NOTE: Observers and scholarship recipients are not included when calculating the total number of paying students.

Advantage Scholarship: Presented to Studio Directors in an effort to encourage dancers to embrace the full convention experience. Each studio that brings 40 or more full paying dancers to the workshop will receive a single convention scholarship to award to one dancer from their studio. This allows the student to come back to one convention workshop free of charge during the 2019-2020 regional season!

CONCIERGE SERVICE

This service will provide you a dedicated representative to assist in all aspects of your experience. This is a private phone line given out to Studio Owners/Directors at the time of check-in. Your concierge will be available to help facilitate prop load-in times, music submissions, wristbands, competition scheduling, discount hotel rooms (when applicable), luggage storage, and other key elements to help make your weekend run as smoothly as possible.

SCHOLARSHIPS

All Mini, Junior, Teen and Senior dancers registered for the full event and not part of the Honored Dancer Experience, will participate in scholarship auditions. Dancers must audition by their age level as of January 1, 2019. If a dancer moves up to a higher level for classes, they **MUST** audition in that same level room for scholarships. If a dancer moves down an age level, they will not be eligible for scholarships. The Faculty awards scholarships based on ability, level of participation, enthusiasm, and interaction with other dancers. Dancers are only eligible for one scholarship per national event.

CORE Scholarships: Awarded to Mini, Junior, Teen, and Senior age divisions as selected by the National Dance Honors faculty. Recipients of this scholarship receive full convention tuition to any single 2019 Summer Event and can bring 1 friend for 50% off.



Convention Scholarship: Awarded to Sparks, Mini, Junior, Teen and Senior age divisions. Recipients of this scholarship are entitled to one free regional convention tuition to both Adrenaline and Revive and one National Dance Honors event for the following season. Convention attendees will be chosen through an audition and Honored Dancer Nominees are chosen by their Crew Choreographers.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- All ages are as of January 1, 2019
- Scholarships are valid from the date of presentation until August 31, 2020. Only convention workshop fees are paid. All other expenses, such as competition fees, are not included in the scholarship award
- Scholarships are single use only and cannot be transferred from one convention to another. Dancers who receive scholarships of equal value at both Adrenaline and Revive may apply the total amount to one national event only.
- Scholarships awarded at one convention are non-transferable or exchangeable for another convention
- All scholarships must be used before the expiration date printed on the scholarship voucher
- One-day registration students are NOT eligible for scholarships
- Dancers ages 20+ are not eligible for scholarships
